





## **Post handover Ambulance RAP process**


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- ED Nurse Prints Wristband to AMB RAP Printer and Ensures PRF has been given to receptionists


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- ED Nurse/Nursing Assistant Scans Wristband Using Observation Machine (Observations Automatically uploaded to CRS)


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- ED Doctor/Nurse Completes RAP Assessment of Patient

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- RAP team to ensure patient is undressed into a hospital gown

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- Further investigations requested

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- Urgent Assessments completed prior to allocation of patient to an appropriate area

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- Portering Team to assist if available in transferring patients to the assigned area

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- SBAR handover given to the ED nurse caring for the Patient and then seen by a doctor for full assessment

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- Decision and plan made within 2 hours 30 mins
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
